

Timetables & to-do lists

	Tasks
Winter	planting (prune, protect and mulch simultaneously if possible) protection of newly planted trees cutting of trees and thinning of woods collecting of grafting material for winter grafting keep an eye on water levels in ponds winter pruning databases (e.g. cleaning of BELTREES database)
January	pruning Hamamelis pruning Hydrangea
February	pruning Buddleja removal of Typha inflorescences
end of February	stop winter pruning when temperature rises
March	pruning of newly planted trees sow all seeds from refrigerator
end of March	start of mowing paths and lawns check and labelling of all newly planted trees for inventory and catalogue
start of April	reorganising perennial beds where necessary
April	spraying Aegopodium inventory of perennial preparing Catalogue beware for snails/slugs esp. in nurseries and perennial beds (also May-June!)
April 15th	start Magnolia crosses check Euonymus for caterpillar regularly
start of May	spraying of tree bases 1
May	start deadheading Rhodo's labelling and registration of young cuttings and seedlings, before planting out spraying grass against oak seedlings, Umbelliferae, etc. 1
end of May	start taking cuttings
June	check for and treat against scale insects and other pests inventory of nurseries plus updating gift-list labelling and yearly control of labels continue taking cuttings
start of July	spraying of tree bases 2
summer	summer pruning
July	cutting hedges, spraying at the bases of the hedges
August	spray Cyclamen cutting of dead trees and shrubs (or earlier for aesthetic reasons) making list of trees and shrubs to cut in winter removal of stock on Rhododendron, Hamamelis, etc. removal of 1-year old side branches on Quercus palustris and robur trunks pocket Catalogue for internal use
end of August	spraying of tree bases 3 spraying grass against oak seedlings, Umbelliferae, etc. 2 collecting seed of Magnolia wilsonii and sinensis check status crosses
September	reorganising perennial beds where necessary (evaluation in summer) stop shading cuttings in greenhouse, reducing watering
end of September	collecting seed on Magnolia and target taxa
October	transplanting cuttings and seedlings (or earlier whenever there is time)
mid October	end of weekly mowing regime preparing against frost (e.g. pumps etc.) planning planting, cutting, thinning, moves
November	continue planning planting, cutting, thinning, moves starting planting esp. big moves (weather dependant)
December	continue planting (weather dependant) mow where we have the yearly mowing regime (or earlier, weather dependant)

WINTER

Planting + mulch + protect + prune

Some winter pruning:

General (rubbing branches, stock, etc.)

Hamamelis, Buddleja, Hydrangea, Typha, etc.

Inside work (databases etc)

Cut list (white paper in tree)

Labelling



Spring

- Start mowing if and where necessary
- Inventory newly planted trees & shrubs
- (re)organize perennial beds (evaluation in Summer)
- Catalogue
- Snails
- crossings on *Magnolia*
- spray aggressive weeds (e.g. *Aegopodium*)
- first spraying tree circles
- Sowing seed (refrigerator)

End of March
start of weekly mowing regime





May 11th

Cuttings and seedlings go outside
(labelling and registering)

Deadheading *Rhododendron*

Cuttings of target taxa

May







Summer

- Check pests
- Inventory of nurseries (gift list)
- Inventory plus evaluations
- Big jobs (dry in summer)
- Cut dead plants
- Summer pruning
- Shaving hedges (spray/mulch)











Autumn

- Continue evaluation
- Perennials
- Collect seed / check crosses
- Mowing where we have year regime
- Late autumn prepare for frosts (water & plants)
- Planting, cutting, thinning, moves and big moves
